Mascot Care Instructions



Plastic Molded Head

Wipe down inside of head with a solution of mild detergent and water or a disinfectant wipe after each use. Spot clean outside with mild detergent and pat dry with clean cloth. Air out head before storing.



Foam Head

Spray inside with disinfectant as needed. Spot clean outside with mild detergent. Pat dry with a clean, white cloth. Air out head before storing.



Jumpsuit, Body Pod Cover, Gloves

Machine wash in cold water or spot clean soiled areas with a mild detergent and water. Air dry.



Fur Feet

Remove slippers and machine wash in cold water; air dry. Machine wash outer covering in cold water and let it air dry. Spray inside of feet with disinfectant as needed.



Tennis Shoes

Remove slippers and machine wash in cold water; air dry. Spot clean outside with mild detergent and water; air dry. Clean vinyl with the same mild detergent and wipe with a clean cloth. Spray inside with disinfectant as needed.



Hats

Spot clean the outside with mild detergent. Dry with a clean, white cloth.



Clothing

Machine wash in cold water; air dry.

General Care Information

- · After components are dry, brush fur with wire animal brush to keep fluffy.
- · Always use a mild detergent when cleaning your mascot. NEVER use bleach.
- \bullet Do NOT apply heat to any of the costume components. Air dry only.
- · Make sure costume is completely dry before storing.

- Store your character in a clean and dry area. It is best to hang your costume rather than fold. If hanging is not an option, be sure to fold neatly and place in a storage bag to prevent any unnecessary soiling.
- To help keep a fresh smell, store with a dryer sheet.
- Store foam costumes on a stand, up off the ground to avoid crushing the costume.
